MICRODERMABRASION

The ancient Egyptians are said to be the first to use alabaster and pumice to remove blemishes and rough spots making their skin smooth and soft. In the mid 90's a skin care technique using aluminum oxide powder for microdermabrasion was developed in Italy. This powder is accelerated through a small orifice with a vacuum machine to abrade the skin using the vacuum to clean out blocked pores.
